HYGIENE

- Wash your hands regularly.

FIRES

- Call the emergency services.

- During the journey, remain vigilant and respect the highway code.


MOVEMENT AROUND THE WORKSITE

- Be careful of machines and vehicles.
- Let the driver know you are there.




WORKING IN TRAFFIC

- Work within the marked area.
- Keep signs in place.




TRENCH WORK

- Always work within the shoring.
- Use the ladders to get inside the shoring.



VEHICLES

- Make sure you have a driving licence.
- After being trained, follow the operating instructions.
- Wear the seat belt.

- Respect the safety zones around overhead cables.

 Identify the network from the colour of the warning grid and clear it manually.



PORTABLE TOOLS

- Never remove protective guards from the machine.
- Lubricate while working, by spraying the cutting area.
- Make sure the tool comes to a complete stop before placing it on the ground



MANUAL HANDLING

- Use handling equipment to move loads.
- Ask for help, if necessary.



LIFTING - SLINGING

- Guide the manoeuvre and never stand under the load.
- Use suitable lifting accessories in good condition.



DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES

- Wear your personal protection (gloves, goggles, mask...) at all times.
- Close containers after use and store products in specific places.
